### **Activity/Project Description:**

- > To begin, students select one noun and one verb from each lesson, or they may select words from the dictionary
- Students create an illustrated flashcard for their words. Cards can be tacked to a bulletin board, or kept in file boxes.
- For sentence construction, students choose a noun and a verb and tack it to the board in proper order. Begin with neutered forms; add (optional) articles.
- Students speak their sentences and explain their meaning.
- > Students construct increasingly complex sentences by adding cards to these sentences and/or creating new cards for various verb conjugations/aspects, in this order; 1) Aspects of time 2)Noun possessives 3) Adjective 4)Adverb 5)Postpositions & Second noun 6)Verb conjugations 7)Interrogatives 8)Multiple adjective/adverb
