Activity/Project Description:

- The teacher uses emoticon flash cards, his/her own body language and/or student volunteers to illustrate feelings.
- Teacher presents illustrated scenario cards to the kids (or the kids present them to each other). Each scenario will evoke an emotion; kids pantomime feelings and students guess the emotion.
 - The scenario cards should be made so that they can be arranged to form simple stories that the kids tell using some Dee Ni vocabulary. Scenarios will include illustrations of Dee Ni vocabulary learned in other lessons (insects, colors, shapes, transportation, etc.).
